# CANDY SALE DETAILS

## CANDY SALE KICK OFF DAY:

**SATURDAY, MARCH 13, 2010**, you can pick up candy from **10 A.M.** till **2 P.M.** at the Lake County Office in Waukegan. At our candy sale kick off day, you can register for camp if you haven't already done so. You can also meet camp staff and volunteers, make new friends and have a great time!

**NO** candy sale pick ups will be offered outside of the scheduled times.

**ALL CANDY** must be paid for before it can be taken out. No candy will be allowed to be distributed until it has been paid for.

Candy may be sold from door to door with an adult. If you wish to sell at a local store, bank or business, you must get permission from them in advance.

## **ONLY UNOPENED BOXES MAY BE RETURNED!!**

We strongly suggest that all money turned in be in the form of a check, money order or credit card. This will provide you with a record of the amount you have turned in for the candy sale.

# 2010 CANDY SELECTION



This variety pack includes:

- 15 Milk Chocolate with Almonds
- 5 Dark Chocolate with Almonds
- 10 Chocolate with Crisp
- 10 Milk Chocolate
- 10 Chocolate with Caramel

There are 50 bars per pack and each camper receives 50% of the profit. That equals \$25 per pack. That's right! This IS a non-profit fundraiser! A 50% fundraiser rate for our campers! (The other 50% pays for the box from the vendors)

## **EARN MY WAY TO CAMP?**

For example, you can sell several boxes of candy towards your camp balance, or you can sell a high volume of boxes to earn your one week or two week session.

If you sell more than your camp balance, the credit will apply toward your bus fare, additional program fee, or your Trading Post account.
