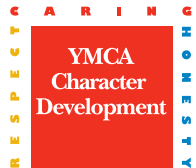

POSITION TITLE	DESCRIPTION	OPENINGS
Program Director	Responsible to develop and oversee the camp cabin activity and program schedules and assign teaching and supervisory staff as appropriate. One program dir. will be responsible for Junior Counselors and the other responsible for Counselors.	1
Program Director	Responsible to develop and oversee the camp cabin activity and program schedules and assign teaching and supervisory staff as appropriate.	1
Leadership Director	Responsible for ensuring safe and smooth programming for the LIT, MIT, and CJ Intern programs. Supervise the LIT/MIT/CJ Intern staff and coordination of supplies.	1
Water-Ski Director	Responsible for all aspects of our water skiing program including care of professional ski boat and equipment and supervision of water ski instructor staff. Instructional classes are held each day and tubing is offered as an elective activity.	1
Trips Director	Responsible for developing, organizing and supervising all out-camping programs. Safety and minimum impact camping techniques are top priorities. Responsible for teaching outdoor living skills, tripping knowledge and expertise to counseling staff during staff training prior to camp sessions. Also, responsible for upkeep of equipment and supervision of Trip's Assistant.	1
Asst. Cook	Responsible for assisting Cook with sanitation, food preparation and meal service. Will supervise Kitchen Manager.	1
Horsemanship Director	Responsible for total operation of horse riding programs. Organize and teach lessons, supervise trail rides, ensure safety and care of animals and facilities. Will supervise and work with Horsemanship Instructor.	1
Waterfront Director	Responsible for programming/supervision of swimming, sailing and canoeing class instruction, as well as all safety standards and emergency procedures. Min. age 21. Lifeguard, WSI certificates required.	1
Cabin Counselor	General resident camp program. Cabin groups consist of 6-10 campers, 1 counselor and 1 high school student as a Junior Counselor. Counselors teach classes in AM and lead cabin activities in afternoons/evenings. Also, may act as trip leader for 1-3 day canoe/backpack trips. Training from June 13- June 20, 2009, required.	12
Program Instructors/ Assistants	Responsible for specific program area. Certs/Exp. in certain specialties req'd - Naturalist, Archery, Sailing, Crafts, Water-Ski, Target Sports, Canoe/Kayak, Horse, Swim, Trips. Maintain equipment, plan and improve programs.	1 each
Junior Counselor	High school students ages 17 + may apply for this position. They are trained and offered experience as camp staff. Participants must take part in staff training prior to camp. Many will remain at camp the entire camp season (approx. 8 wks). Hiring decisions are based on age, previous camp experience, references, related training and completion of Camp Jorn leadership programs.	12
