Camp will be implementing a host of new behaviors and practices while your kids are at camp. Please support this commitment by ensuring habit forming practice of the CDC recommended guidelines and monitoring your children's health prior to camp and throughout the summer. Together, we can make the Camp 2020 experience one to remember!

DAY CAMP GUIDELINES 4.0

Health: Screening and Preventing COVID-19

- Children should not be at Day Camp with any combination of the following symptoms:
 - Temperature of 100.3 or above
 - Coughing
 - Difficulty breathing
- If your child may have been exposed to COVID-19 or a high risk area, please do not send them to day camp. - All campers will have temperatures checked each morning at check in.
- If a child becomes ill while at camp, child will be in an isolated space for them to rest while waiting for arrival of parent/guardian.
- Parent/guardian must agree to pick a child up immediately when contacted if child becomes ill. - **If your child presents with symptoms of COVID-19, you and your child have 2 options before returning to camp:**
 - **Option A: Get your camper tested and they are medically cleared to return**
 - **Option B: Quarantine for 14 days and return to camp after**

CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT: CAR RIDERS

Staff wear masks if communicating with parents in cars

Check-In:

- Parents will pull up to the designated check-in spot and roll down window
 - 8 yrs old & Up by Archery
 - 7 yrs old & Under at the main entrance
- While in the car, the child's temperature will be checked and if the temp is under 100.3, the child can be signed in - If child's temperature is over 100.3, the child will remain in the car and will be not allowed to attend day camp until they have been fever free for 24 hours
- If kid's temperature is below 100.3 and they are permitted to sign in, they can join the other campers - All kids will have hand sanitizer applied to their hands before entering camp

CAMPJORN YMCA

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Check-Out:

- ID Check Point - staff has radio and list of ALL car rider campers with their groups included ○
Ask for name of campers & check ID for each camper
 - Staff member calls for Camper on radio with group announced
 - Parents drive and park in parking lot waiting for staff member
 - Staff (wearing mask) walks campers out to cars - SIGN OUT CAMPER with parent

Early Check Out:

- If your camper is leaving, please notify the office about your approximate time of arrival
- Please stay in your vehicle upon arrival, staff will meet you in the parking lot with your camper ready to go

Entrance & Transportation:

CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT: BUS RIDERS

****Staff wear masks if communicating with parents in cars****

- Check-In
 - Parents will pull up to the designated check-in spot and roll down window
 - While in the car, the child's temperature will be checked and if the temp is under 100.3, the child can be signed in
- If child's temperature is over 100.3, the child will remain in the car and will be not allowed to attend day camp until they have been fever free for 24 hours
- If kid's temperature is below 100.3 and they are permitted to sign in, they can join the other campers for the bus
- Riding the bus
 - All kids will have hand sanitizer applied to their hands before boarding the bus
 - All kids will be required to wear masks on the bus to and from camp. Each child will try to have their own seat but no more than two to a seat with backpacks between them to promote distancing. Siblings can sit together
 - Upon arrival at camp kids will be dropped off at their assigned area
- Check-Out
 - Upon arrival parents will remain in vehicle and campers will remain on bus until dismissed
 - Staff member will check ID and campers will be walked up and put in car
 - Bus rider campers put on masks and as a staff member leads bus campers to line up at buses ○ All kids will have temp checked before boarding buses. Any temps of 100.3 or more will require parents to come pick up their child
 - Children can lay down and drink water in the Health Lodge sick room while waiting for their parent
 - Parent will sign out children at the office and camper will be brought to the parent
- Bus Care:
 - All busses will be sanitized before every run
 - All busses wiped down every evening
 - One child/two children per seat. No longer allow three to a seat





Late Check in:

- If your camper is arriving late please notify the office about your approximate time of arrival - Please stay in your vehicle upon arrival, staff will meet you in the parking lot for your campers temp check prior to sign in
- If child's temperature is over 100.3, the child will remain in the car and will be not allowed to attend day camp until they have been fever free for 24 hours
- If kid's temperature is below 100.3 and they are signed in, they can join the other campers - All kids will have hand sanitizer applied to their hands before entering camp

Dining Hall & Eating Areas:

- Campers will have lunch and snacks with their specific group in their cabin
- We will be hosting lots of BBQ days along with campfire cookouts for the older groups

Activity Areas:

- Mandatory use of hand sanitizer/washing for all participants before activity use
- All equipment will be sanitized and cleaned before and after each use
- Less than 10 participants will be allowed to do an activity at a time
- Swim time will look a bit different with each group based on age with have a structured swim time to reduce contact with many campers

Group Sizes & Precautions:

- All groups will be 10 campers or less
- Groups will stay together much of the time to create less exposure to other campers
- Counselors will carry hand sanitizer with their groups to ensure sanitization practices

****NEW ACTIVITIES OFFERED:**

- We will be offering waterskiing lessons to campers 8 yrs old and up
 - o Parents can sign their camper up for daily and weekly lessons with an additional fee
 - o \$26/day or \$130/week
 - o Campers can only sign up if they are at camp



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
